

NYS Health Requirements

New York State Dept. of Health requirements for attending school.

Immunizations:

All new students, including K4 & Kindergarten, are required to provide proof of immunization by the first day of school. We will need an immunization record with a doctor's signature on it. You may have your doctor's office mail or fax a copy to us. Fax# is 270-1659.

These are required immunizations for K-12th:

- 4 DPT (triple vaccine) Students 11 years old are required to have TDap
- 3 Polio (IPV/OPV)
- 2 Mumps, Measles, & Rubella
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 4 Hib
- 4 PVC
- 2 Chicken Pox
- 2 Meningococcal Disease (1 before 7th grade & 1 before 12th Grade)

These are the required immunizations for K4:

- 4 DPT (triple vaccine)
- 3 Polio (IPV/OPV)
- 1 Mumps, Measles, Rubella
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 3 Hib
- 3 PCV
- 1 Chicken Pox

Physicals:

Physicals are required for all new students, and those entering K4, Kindergarten, 2nd, 4th, 7th & 10th grades. This must be obtained from your own physician and dated not more than 12 months prior to the date of starting school. An immunization record must also be received by the start of school. Both items **MUST** be signed and dated by your physician.

Medications:

In order for the school to administer medication in school, we must have the following items brought to the Nurse's office.

1. Signed permission from the parent.
2. Prescription order that includes child's name, physician's signature, name of drug, amount to administer, when & how often. Each child in a family needs their own prescription, even if it is the same medication.
